Madeleine Way: Measuring and Mapping Quality In Cider

Madeleine is a graduate of UTAS Agricultural Science and is currently completing her PhD. Madeleine, 22 of Cambridge, graduated with a Bachelor of Agricultural Science with Honours in 2016. In recognition of her Honours project, Madeleine received a \$120,000 Westpac Future Leaders Scholarship. She has judged at our Fruit Wine and Cider Show and also at the Fine Food Awards. Madeleine explained that cider is fermented apple juice and it is easy to make. The really tricky bit is to make good cider. Good cider a fine balance of organic compounds called phenolics which give it taste, mouth feel and ensures it "packs a punch". Madeleine's PhD investigates the contributions of phenolics, apple varieties, yeast and regional influences in the making of Australian Cider. It was a fascinating and informative presentation which generated many interesting questions from the audience.
