Rotary and ShelterBox Celebrate the power of partnership

You all received ShelterBox's Newsletter last week. Here's the slant on Rotary's connection from RC Launceston, Tasmania's Liason Club

Rotary is a global network whose members take action to make a lasting difference in their communities – and world-wide.

ShelterBox for almost twenty years has been a unique humanitarian alliance that has supported families with a place to call home after a disaster.

What began as a local connection with one Cornish Rotary Club has led to an international movement that's provided 140,000 ShelterBox family tents or 390,000 ShelterKits worldwide to the value of over £54 million.

In 2012 ShelterBox became Rotary's Project Partner in Disaster Relief and this partnership has helped to transform ShelterBox into an internationally recognised disaster relief charity, supporting families with emergency shelter.

Around 1,000 Rotary members are involved in ShelterBox as volunteers, staff or response team members.

Rotary International General Secretary John Hewko said that through this project partnership, Rotary members around the globe collaborate with ShelterBox to support communities in desperate need of emergency temporary shelter and vital supplies.
