Rotary Tasmania Friendship Mission to South America



Join with us in exploring the lost city of Machu Picchu when you board the Vistadome train as you ascend the mountainside to the “Lost City of the Incas.” Immerse yourself in the crafts and arts of the Sacred Valley. Stay at Copacabana Beach and take a cog railway 700metres to the summit to view the infamous Christ the Redeemer statue.

Package includes 24 nights ex Tasmania and includes international fares, 21 breakfasts, 1 lunch and 20 dinners, all internal flights, quality hotels, tour director and free time to explore.

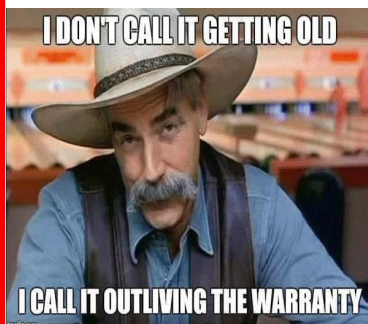
