a member of the Salamanca RC for 23 years and in April/May of this year had a wonderful adventure in Tanzania learning and contributing to Care For Africa. Diane learned of the plight of patients and the medical services in Tanzania by overhearing a conversation about doctors doing surgery by candlelight in a remote hospital. With the help of the Deloraine RC she arranged to send a generator and medical supplies to the hospital. To gain more information Diane went to Tanzania to see, in person, what is happening. She soon found that water was the main priority and other things

happen if it is readily available. It has taken 17 years but the improvements made have been remarkable. On her recent trip Ruth and other Rotarians saw well nourished children, education and empowerment of women and girls, the creation of numerous bores bringing fresh water to communities and medical centres. Ruth spoke of several impressive programs making a real difference to the lives of local people, often created by their own drive and initiative. Ruth's presentation was very interesting and inspiring.
