CHANGEOVER MEETING - BYC

BRETT MORRIS - PREDICTING SHARE MARKET CRASHES

One of our newest members Brett was happy to volunteer to be our Guest Speaker at last week's meeting. Before his retirement Brett worked in financial planning for 37 years, working for several large companies. He began by talking about the Black Tuesday crash in October 1987. This saw the share market in

Australia drop in value by 25% in one day causing many to lose their fortunes large and small. Worldwide losses were estimated at US\$1.71 trillion. It was the first financial crisis of global proportions, demonstrating how interconnected the financial markets had become through the advent of computer driven electronic trading. Following the crash Brett began to use computers and other key indicators to try to predict when crashes may happen. He developed his own software which he uses to

analyze the peaks and troughs of trading to try to calculate when is the optimum time to buy and sell shares to avoid potential losses. He demonstrated how it could have been possible to predict crashes starting with the biggest in 1929 through to the GFC in 2007 and the COVID crash in 2020. However it is a tricky business and Brett feels there is currently not enough data to be absolutely sure. Maybe in another 100 years? It was a really interesting presentation that generated lots of questions. Many thanks Brett.
