DR.WARRICK BISHOP - **BONE HEALTH** Dr. Warrick Bishop is a practicing cardiologist, author, and keynote speaker and who is keen to help prevent heart disease and improving bone density and strength. Warrick graduated from the UTAS, School of Medicine, in 1988. He completed his advanced training in cardiology in Hobart, before becoming a fellow of the Royal Australian College of Physicians. In addition Warrick is the franchise partner of Osteo Strong in Hobart. He was accompanied by Chelle Spicer, who is also a franchise partner and Centre Manager of OsteoStrong Hobart. OsteoStrong uses four pieces of equipment and unlike typical weight machines the equipment uses only your body weight to load the bones in specific ways and apply targeted forces on the skeleton. This stimulates bone growth as well as strength gain, which can improve posture, agility, and balance. In theory, each machine focuses on

different areas of the body to spur measurable bone growth. Strangely OsteoStrong seems to require less time and effort than usual gym sessions with only a single all-out hold instead of multiple reps and sets. Other therapies offered included Hydro Massage, Pulsed Electromagnetic Field (PEMFT) and Red Light. While at times his presentation felt a little like a recruiting drive Warrick provided lots of interesting facts and figures to spark interest and a desire to further investigate how to improve our bone health and strength.
