**The good result was a real plus for Bunnings! Well done everyone!**

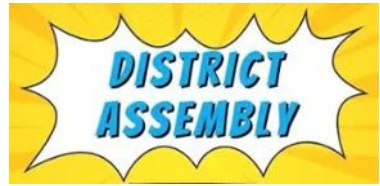
