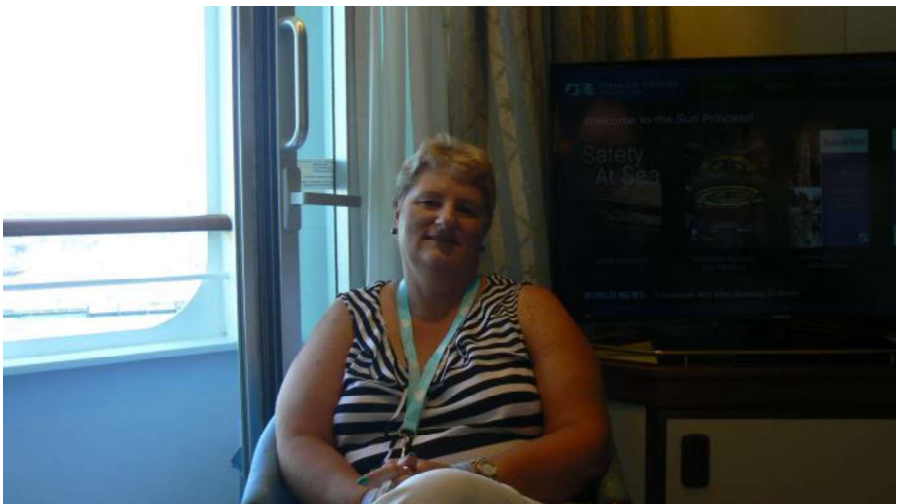


## GUEST REPORTER - JUNE'S STORY
